



A small percentage of school districts were in fiscal stress.


Fiscal Stress Designation, SY 2019-20

Moderate	1.0%
Susceptible	3.3%
Total in Stress	4.6%
No Designation	94.8%
Total Filed and Scored	99.4%
Not Filed or Inconclusive	0.6%



Fiscal Stress Risks in SY 2020-21


- The COVID-19 pandemic that began in early 2020 has already had an impact on school district finances.
- Some of the fiscal challenges that districts are facing that could impact the components of their Fiscal Stress Monitoring Scores include the loss of revenues from State aid and an increase in pandemic-related expenditures.

Fiscal Stress Risks in 2020: State Aid

- State Aid comprises a high percent of total revenues, especially for high-need districts.
- The State has begun withholding 20 percent from State aid to school districts.






