Financial indicators 1 through 5 only use data from the General (A) Fund, but indicator 6 looks for short-term cash-flow debt in all funds.



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Fiscal Stress Trends



- Very few districts experience significant fiscal stress.
- However, the number of school districts designated in stress has risen over the past two years.



Fiscal Stress and District Wealth



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
COVID Funding as a Share of Federal Aid





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Low Fund Balance

- For SY 2023-24, 5.2 percent of schools scored reported low fund balance
- This figure has been increasing since SY 2020-21, but is lower than the peak of 8.2 percent in SY 2018-19




Potential SY 2023-24 Risks

- CARES Act, CRRSA and ARPA funding are winding down.
- With the new Administration, the future of federal funding for education is uncertain.
- Changes to State aid are also possible. The State's commitment to fully fund Foundation Aid is non-binding on future legislatures.


