REVISION TO BULLETIN P-518

The Director of Classification and Compensation has revised the smallest unit of time an eligible employee must work during an overtime shift in order to receive hazardous differential from one hour to one-quarter hour. Once an eligible employee works in excess of 40 hours during a workweek and qualifies for overtime pay, the employee is entitled to payment of the differential at the time and one-half rate of \$.64 per hour (or quarterly segment thereof).

The smallest unit to be worked during a normal work day remains at one hour.
