December 1988 Salary Increase for Employees of the Security Services and Security Supervisors Negotiating Units Bulletin No.

P-583

Chapter 578 of the Laws of 1988 which implements the agreements between the State and Council 82 representing employees in the Security Services (01) and Security Supervisors (61) Negotiating Units provides for a salary increase for these employees and a new Salary Schedule effective December 1 (Institutions) and December 8 (Administration), 1988.

The increase is .0096% (1% non-compounded) over the April/May 1988 salary schedule, which is the amount necessary to bring the total percentage increase within the fiscal year to 5%. A copy of the December 1988 Salary Schedule is attached.

The salary increase is effective from the first day of Institution Payroll Period 18L (December 1-14, 1988) and Administration Period 19L (December 8-21, 1988) and will be paid in Institution checks dated December 29, 1988 and Administration checks dated January 4, 1989.

#### NOTE

With the payment of the second part of the 1988-89 Security Services/Supervisors salary increase, it will no longer be necessary to recalculate the general salary increase for this fiscal year when an employee moves between positions in one of the Security Units and a different bargaining unit.

#### Payment of the Increase

The salary increase is applied as follows:

For employees whose annual salary is identical to the Hiring Rate, performance advance rate 1, 2, 3, the job rate or the longevity steps of the salary grade of their position on the April/May 1988 salary schedule, the salary will be increased to the hiring rate, performance advance rate 1, 2, 3, the job rate or the corresponding longevity step on the attached December 1988 salary schedule.

For employees whose annual salary is not equal to any step on the April/May 1988 salary schedule and those in NS (grade 600) or Trainee (grade 800) positions, the salary will be increased by .0096% rounded to the next whole dollar amount.

#### Correction Officer Trainees

The rates for Correction Officer Trainee are increased as follows:

\$19261 First 13 Payroll Periods \$20344 Second 13 Payroll Periods

Correction Officer Trainees who had prior service in a graded position and held their attained graded salary, rather than the Trainee rate, will have their salary increased by .0096%.

#### Tentative Salary Register

After payrolls are processed for Institution Period 17L and Administration Period 18L, OSC will convert the computer records to reflect the salary increase in both negotiating units, and increase in Pre-Shift Briefing Pay for the Security Services negotiating unit.

### Adjustment of Pre-Shift briefing pay (NU 01)

OSC will calculate the employee's overtime rate based on the increased annual salary plus differentials, if any, and enter overtime pay for  $2\frac{1}{2}$  hours in the Pre-Shift column and biweekly gross on the tentative payroll. Employees whose overtime pay for  $2\frac{1}{2}$  hours is less than \$48.00 or who are on an extended leave at full pay (sick, education, union, Workers' Compensation leave) and previously reduced by the agency or facility to \$48.00, will remain at \$48.00 on the tentative.

A tentative salary register will be prepared showing computed biweekly gross payments and variable deductions based on the new salaries.

A copy of the tentative salary register and Exception Listing will be forwarded to reach you shortly after your regular salary register for the period. The tentative register will be used as the "previous payroll" for all information supplied on all forms submitted for the next period. OSC will prepare salary payments as they are indicated on the tentative register unless a PR-75 form reporting a change is submitted by the agency. Therefore, the listings should be carefully examined and any corrections made by submission of a PR-75.

The salary increase will be applied as follows:

#### Class of Employees

1. Employees who are active at the end of Institution Period 17L and Administration Period 18L:

OSC will apply the salary increase and, for employees in the Security Services unit the increase in Pre-Shift Briefing Pay. These employees will appear on the Exception Listing with no message.

2. Employees with pay basis code HRY or DLY. OSC will not apply the salary increase. These employees will appear on the Exception Listing with no message.

To calculate the increased salary, first multiply the hourly rate by 2088 and the daily rate by 261 to calculate an annual salary. Increase the annual by .0096% rounded to the next whole dollar. Then divide the new annual salary by 2088 or 261 to determine the new hourly or daily rate.

In preparing your payroll for Period 18L (Institution) and 19L (Administration):

- a. Prepare all PR-75 forms usually submitted for a normal period to report all changes to take effect during that period.
- b. The normal (deduct) on all PR-75 forms should be the amount shown on the tentative register.
- c. The normal amount of previous payroll on the PR-76 should be the amount shown on the tentative register.
